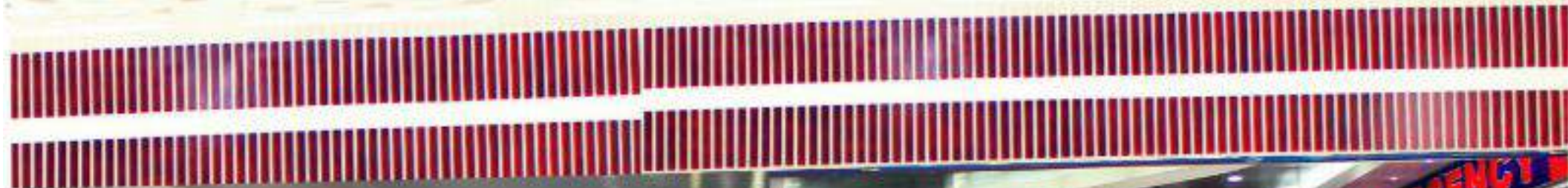

### Why study B.Sc. in Nursing at International Nursing College?

International Nursing College (INC) is one of the pioneers private Nursing Colleges in the country that got permission from the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare to run the B. Sc. in Nursing (Basic & Post Basic) program with the affiliation of Dhaka University. This college was established in 2007 as B.Sc. Nursing Unit, with IMC the seat capacity only 20 per year; henceforth it started running programs since 2008. Now the seat capacity increased in 50 per year and Government declared the B.Sc. Nursing Unit as full-fledged Nursing College.

The students of this unit are mostly taught by highly qualified and renowned teachers in full academic environment. Meanwhile our first four batches students successfully completed the 4 years B.Sc. Nursing course and exempted by Dhaka University. Their result is almost 100 percent passed in every year. Some of the students got distinction marks and stood position in the merit list of Dhaka University.

INC students also have some collaborative programs with Kean University, New Jersey, USA. Like ESL, IELTS and TOFEL courses. English as a Second Language (ESL) certificate course is mandatory for every student to develop skills in English language run by educators for Kean University which is mandatory for every INC student that helps them to success in TOFEL and IELTS scores. After successful completion of ESL course our 1st to 6th batch students received ESL certificate from the Kean University and 7th batch students' course is going on. So, our students have an opportunity to avail prestigious two (02) certificates one from Kean University, USA and another one from the Dhaka University. TOFEL course is already being offered for the first batches students who became Graduate Nurse from this College.

Moreover, INC has both teachers and students exchange program with School of Nursing, Kean University (KU), NJ, USA. ## Features of International Nursing College

### Location

International Nursing College is situated at the 2nd floor of the College Academic Building. It is located at Gushulia at the outskirts of the commercial township of Tongi and is about 22 km away from the zero point of Dhaka. The major bus terminals, main railway station and Hajrat Shahjalal International Airport are within maximum automobile distance of 30 minutes. Amenities and modern facilities of city life are near enough though isolated in the spell-binding scheme of nature, which is truly a unique feature of natural beauty of the Unit.

### The Campus

The maddening busy streets and concrete forests of the capital city keep at a distance from the college. The campus stands in a solitary environment amidst green vegetation, spaced villages and large water bodies. One takes a walk around the campus to take fresh breath while enjoying the panorama. Within this Campus International Medical College Hospital (IMCH) is situated as the teaching hospital of IMC & INC. It is a 600 bedded multidisciplinary Hospital Complex which is located in the proximity to the College building. The present campus of the College comprises over 23 bighas of land. The total floor space of International Medical College & Hospital is 204055 Sft. The existing facilities in various floors are also adequate to meet all study related requirements of MBBS and B.Sc. Nursing students.





### Library Facilities

The central library of the College has a good number of high quality text and academic reference books. Students can study in the library from 8 am to 4 pm and can borrow books without charge.



### Laboratory Facilities

## Program Outline and Selection Criteria for Admission (Basic)

- ❖ Name of the course: B.Sc. in Nursing
- ❖ Academic Year: 4 academic years starts in January each year
- ❖ Total Subjects: 29 (General-4, Foundation-7, and Professional-18)
- ❖ Total hours: 6672 in four years course
- ❖ Medium of instruction: English
- ❖ The applicants must have passed both SSC and HSC Examinations from Science Group with Biology and have cumulative GPA (in SSC and HSC) totals of 6.0 no less than GPA 2.5 in either SSC or HSC Examination.
- ❖ The candidates, are to apply within three years of passing HSC examination
- ❖ The candidates will be selected on merit basis. Merit score will be determined from cumulative GPA of SSC & HSC result and from the admission test result.
- ❖ Medical fitness will be essential before admission.
- ❖ Student will be single.
- ❖ Foreign students having completed 'A' level can also apply for admission submitting attested photocopy of equivalence certificate collected from Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

## Examination System

The regular final exam will be held twice in a year (January and July) under University of Dhaka in written, oral and practical form. A mid-term Examination is being held initially in the first term of each academic year by the International Nursing College. This mid-term is considered as a pre-requisite for year final examination under the University.

**Students' Eligibility to Appear in the Year Final (University) Examination:**  
**A student will be eligible to appear in the Year Final Exam if the following conditions are fulfilled:**

- Has undergone one year academic course in each subjects
- Has attended no less than 80% of the minimum prescribed number of theory classes & 100% clinical/field practice and Laboratory practice separately in each subjects of examination.
- Along with satisfactory certificate from the Principal, concerned Nursing College
- Has passed minimum 60% (Basic B.Sc. in Nursing) and 50% (Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing) marks in the mid-term/internal exam and in formative, clinical assessment/ course work of each subject as specified in the curriculum and exam system of both basic and post basic B.Sc. nursing.
- Has paid the requisite amount of exam fees as decided by the Dhaka University.
- For appearing in the 2nd year, 3rd year, and 4th year final exam, the student must pass the previous year Final exam and fulfill the above criteria (Basic B.Sc. in nursing students only).

## Global Professional Testing Center (The Gateway to the Global Career)

GPTC is the first CGFNS center for conducting CGFNS course by foreign faculty and KTC is the first online testing center to conduct CGFNS examination in Bangladesh. GPTC and KTC both are located at Nikunja, Dhaka.

### What is CGFNS?

CGFNS stands for Commission on Graduate of Foreign Nursing School. It was established in 1977 to ensure that nurses educated outside the United States are eligible and qualified to meet licensure and practice requirement in the U.S. It is an immigration neutral nonprofit organization globally recognized as an authority on credentials evaluation of the education, registration and licensure of nurses worldwide.

### Eligibility: The eligibility for CGFNS program

1. A nurse to hold both initial and current valid registration to practice as a first level general nurse.
2. She/he should have successfully completed higher secondary school certificate education.
3. Should have graduated from a Govt. approved Nursing school/ Institute/ College and must have completed sufficient classroom teaching and clinical practice in;
  - a. Nursing Care Management. (b). Adult Medical Surgical Nursing (c). Reproductive Health Nursin. (d). Pediatric Nursing. (e). Psychiatric and mental Health Nursin

An eligible candidate can apply for the CGFNS certification program in a prescribed form along with pre-selected fees. The CGFNS certification program is comprised of following three (03) components.

1. A credentials review on higher Secondary School & Nursing education, registration and licensure of an applicant for CGFNS.
2. The Internationally recognized English language exam. like TOFEL, IELTS at least score 6.5
3. A one day CGFNS qualifying examination.

Upon successful completion of all above three components of the program the applicant is awarded a CGFNS certificate.

### Requirements for CGFNS Exam

- Complete application form
- One copy recent passport size photograph which has to be signed on the front & back.
- Valid passport & visa.
- Higher Secondary School Educations' documents
- Full Nursing Academic documents from Nursing school/ college where he/she passed.
- Valid registration/ license as a first level general nurse.





### Structure of CGFNS Exam:

CGFNS qualifying exam is a one day paper pencil examination and it consists of multiple choice questions, alternate or objective type questions, The questions is given in two parts which is known as Nursing part-I and Nursing part-II. Total 150 questions are given in the part-I exam with a time limit of 2 hours and 30 minutes, Nursing part-II exam consists of 121 question with a time limit of 2 hours only. The CGFNS qualifying exam tests one's knowledge of nursing principles & skills and one's understanding of how nursing is taught and practiced in the US today. It also designed to help examinee predict their likelihood that they will pass the NCLEX-RN (National Council Licensing Examination) and they build up their professional career in USA near future.





## Internship

The students successfully passing the final B.Sc. in Nursing (BSN) examination will have to undergo at least six month internship training in the College Hospital (IMCH). During internship, training subsistence will be given to the interns.
