Introduction

B.Sc. Nursing Unit of International Medical College (IMC) conducts high quality academic program to produce nurses as per international standard. It intends to kindle light of learning in its students that matches with the need of healthcare employment market both in home and abroad. The total set up of B.Sc. Nursing Unit, IMC has been organized in a well planned way, so that the students can acquire all necessary skills which are essential for their profession.

Vision

B.Sc. Nursing Unit, IMC will be a high standard education centre, to educate and prepare knowledgeable competent, confident and committed nurses to provide quality care to the people.

Philosophy

Nursing profession is a noble profession utilizing body of knowledge and art to apply scientific principles in providing standard and quality nursing care for people. It is our belief and commitment to provide quality nursing education for the new generation.

Mission

B.Sc. Nursing Unit, IMC defines its mission as follows:-

- To educate future professional nurses who would possess knowledge and competencies at the national and international standard relevant to social needs.
- To enhance students to be a self-oriented, moral, accountable, self-directed and self-developed person who would always be ready to provide quality nursing service.
- To utilize knowledge in helping people for developing and / or maintaining quality of life, improving nursing profession and society
- To conduct B.Sc. Nursing (BSN) to produce highly skilled nursing manpower and teacher.

Goal

After completion the Bachelor Science degree in nursing a graduate will be a competent professional nurse who can demonstrate the competency of using knowledge based practice for provision of holistic client centered Quality Nursing & Midwifery Service. A Graduate would provide care to meet needs and expectations and to promote, maintain and restore health of individual, families and communities in commons.

Location

B.Sc. Nursing Unit, IMC is situated at the 2nd floor of the Academic Building. It is located at the Gushulia at the outskirts of the commercial township of Tongi and is about 22 km away from the zero point of Dhaka. The major bus stands/terminals, main railway station and Hajrat Shahjalal International Airport are within maximum automobile distance of 30 minutes. Amenities and modern facilities of city life is near enough though isolated in the spell-binding scheme of nature, which is truly a unique feature of natural beauty of the Unit.

The Campus

The maddening busy streets and concrete forests of the capital city keeps at a distance from the college. The campus stands in a solitary environment amidst green vegetation,



spaced villages and large water bodies. One takes a walk around the campus to take fresh breath while enjoying the panorama. International Medical College Hospital is the teaching hospital of the college as well as of B.Sc. Nursing Unit. It is a 650 bed multidisciplinary Hospital Complex which is located in the proximity to the College building. The present campus of the College comprises over 23 bighas of land. The total floor space of International Medical College & Hospital is 2,04,055 sqft. The Total under construction floor space is 126828 sqft. The existing facilities in various floors are also adequate to meet all study related requirements of MBBS and B.Sc. Nursing students.

Faculty

Academic Faculty of the College now consists of over 200 members; which is a blend of a distinguished body of senior academics with proven teaching and research excellence and young enthusiastic but dedicated professionals. Like MBBS students, B.Sc. Nursing Unit students, too, are taught by Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors and other professionals.

Library Facilities

The central library of the College has a good number of high quality text and academic reference books. Students can study in the library from 8 am to 4 pm and can borrow books without charge. Besides B.Sc. Nursing Unit has also a library of its own where exclusively nursing students study.

Laboratory Facilities

There are required numbers of laboratory facilities for the subjects like Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, Nutrition & Dietetics, Computer & IT, Fundamentals of Nursing, Midwifery and also English with sufficient number of specimen, equipments and instruments. Students avail all lab facilities for fulfilling the prescribed lab practicing hours of curriculum.

Clinical Practice Facilities

Students are placed in real situation for clinical practice both in hospital and community as per requirement of curriculum. To fulfill the required practical hours students do their clinical practice in various ward of IMCH throughout the year for 2 weeks in each month under the supervision of subject teacher.

Hostel Facilities

The College has the hostel facilities for the female students in its own premises. Male students live in a rented house adjacent to college campus with the supervision of college authority and under the guidance of Nursing Unit teachers.

Transport Facilities

Students, living in Dhaka city can avail the college buses for their transportation to and from the campus at free of cost. They, who reside at Dhanmondi, Mohammadpur, Shamoli, Gabtali, Mirpur, Tongi, Uttara, Khilkhat, Banani, Mohakhali, DOHS, Tejgaon, Shahbagh or areas adjacent to these get easy transport facility. Students from other areas of Dhaka, Tongi and Gazipur can also use this facility at the nearest selected spots in above mentioned areas. The students who live in college hostel usually avail college buses to go Tongi and Dhaka for shopping and other necessary purposes around the week.

Selection Criteria for Admission

- ★ The applicants must have passed both SSC and HSC Examinations from Science Group with Biology and have cumulative GPA (in SSC and HSC) totals of 6.0 no less than GPA 2.5 in either SSC or HSC Examination.
- ★ The candidates are to apply within three years of passing HSC examination.
- ★ The applicants have to appear and qualify in the Admission Test arranged by the College / Unit.
- ★ Foreign students having completed 'A' level can also apply for admission submitting attested photocopy of equivalence certificate collected from Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.
- ★ Procedure that is followed for the selection of foreign students is same to that of domestic students.
- ★ Selection Committee selects the students according to the merit.

A mid-term Examination is being held initially in the first term of each academic year by the B.Sc. Nursing Unit. This mid-term is considered as a pre-requisite for year final examination under the University.

Total Marks: 1300 in each year

Pass marks: 60% marks in each subject individually in written, oral and practical / clinical examinations. The oral and practical exams are taken after written exam. An honors mark is awarded when students achieve 85% or more marks in a subject.

Students' Eligibility to Appear in the Year Final (University) Examination:

A student will be eligible to appear in the Year Final Exam if the following conditions are fulfilled:

- Has undergone one year academic course in each subjects
- Has attended no less than 80% of the minimum prescribed number of theory classes, clinical/field practice and Laboratory practice separately in each subjects of examination.
- Along with satisfactory certificate from the Chief, B.Sc. Nursing unit
- Has passed minimum 60% marks in the mid-term internal exam and in formative and clinical assessment of each subject as specified in the curriculum and exam system.
- Has paid the requisite amount of exam fees as decided
- For appearing in the 2nd year, 3rd year, and 4th year final exam, the student must pass the previous year Final exam and fulfill the above criteria.



Internship

The students successfully passing final B.Sc. Nursing (BSN) examination will have to undergo at least six month internship training in the College Hospital (IMCH). During internship training subsistence wage will be given to the interns.

Rules and Regulations for the Students

Students must follow the academic and administrative discipline carefully. Studentship may strike out from the College under the following circumstance:

- Showing repeated dissatisfactory academic performance.
- Any kind of unruly activity.

What is CGFNS

CGFNS stands for Commission on Graduate of Foreign Nursing School. It was established in 1977 to ensure that nurses educated outside the United States are eligible and qualified to meet licensure and practice requirement in the U.S. It is an immigration neutral nonprofit organization globally recognized as an authority on credentials evaluation of the education, registration and licensure of nurses worldwide.

Eligibility: The eligibility for CGFNS program requires;

To be eligible a candidate must.

- Be a nurse, licensed to practice
- Have a candidate status as a first level, general nurse verified through CGFNS.

The CGFNS Qualifying Exam is an internet-based, objective-format exam. Questions utilize a multiple choice or a multiple selection format. The exam will take 3 hours (about one minute per question). All questions have been designed by subject matter experts. The goal of the exam is to test basic nursing knowledge and concepts.
